For the future our focus is on the quality of education and to improve the teaching methods and the overall academic performance of the

children. Because we believe that a good education is the key to a better future. Two of the cultural walks encompass an actual visit to the Baraa Primary School. A unique way to see how a primary school in Tanzania works and to discover how iThemba created a pleasant learning environment for the children and what projects are being followed-up or launched (the vegetable garden project, the annual health check,...) by iThemba to focus on the quality of education and on the quality of the children's lives.

MERU VILLAGE TOUR

A local guide will take you to Tengeru (5km from Onsea House) where you get the chance of interacting with the villagers and learning more about their culture and day-to- day habits. On Wednesday and Saturday, you can also visit the Market – usually an unforgettable experience.

CULTURAL WALK WITH VISIT TO BARAA PRIMARY SCHOOL

After a short exposé on Tanzania you will start your walk to the school. During this trip you will learn about the local community, ranging from the social structure in a village to the agriculture. In the school, your guide will team up with a pupil and you will learn about the day-to-day life in a Tanzanian primary school and about the iThemba projects. After this you will visit a local crafts shop. Whether it be a fundi (mechanic), a butcher or a recycling project, you're sure to encounter a part of Tanzania few people get to discover.

COFFEE TOUR

This full-day trip takes you to two coffee farms, one run by an individual, and another run by a cooperative. As you walk through the plantations and factories, you will be educated on the entire coffee-processing, and you'll enjoy a cup of coffee with the farmers.

MOUNT MERU WALKING SAFARI

You will be taken to the slope of Mount Meru for an 8km walk through the Mount Meru Forest, an old, thick forest with a magnitude of birds, Colobus monkeys and small antilopes. You will have lunch in a beautiful spot at the top of the waterfall where you have a stunning view over Arusha town.

LAKE DULUTI FOREST RESERVE TOUR

The Duluti-tour takes you to the caldera lake where you can choose between a lake forest walk or a canoe-trip on the lake. What makes this trip so interesting is that, according to local beliefs, the lake hides many stories and is a popular place for worshipping.

MASAI VILLAGE TOUR

About 30km along the Namanga-road is the village of Oldonyoshambu, a traditional Masai village in the middle of the Rift Valley. This trip promotes people-to-people tourism and encourages multicultural friendship.



Next: a visit to a local crafts shop, a daladala trip to the Banana Beer Factory for a visit and then a meal in a local restaurant. Your day ends with an unforgettable visit to the local market.
